Supply List for T-shirt Makeover

- T-shirt kit (includes T-shirts, lace, thread, and ric rack for flower)
- Sewing machine in good working order and machine manual
- Sewing machine feet zig zag foot; open toe or clear foot
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Rotary cutting ruler at least 24 inch long
- Pins, scissors, hand sewing needle
- French curve

 measurement is the T-shirt measurement NOT body measurement.

Supply List for Cosmetic/Notions Bag

- 2 fat quarters, one for bag outside, one for bag inside
- 14 inch or larger zipper that coordinates with fat quarters for bag
- 20" X 24" piece of quilt batting OR Annies Soft n Stable OR In-R Form. The Annies Soft n Stable and the IN-R-Form will give more support to the bag.
- 2 yds of 1 inch ribbon
- Regular sewing thread that matches bag fabric.
- Thread for quilting bag and doing decorative stitch on ribbon –suggestions: Sulky topstitch thread or embroidery thread
- Sewing machine in good working order and machine manual
- New 90/14 Universal or new 90/14 Embroidery sewing machine needle.
- Regular machine foot, Open toe embroidery foot, Edgestitch foot and Zipper foot
- Medium or heavy weight tear away stabilizer
- Scissors, ruler, marking pen, pins

Prior to coming to the class quilt the fabric for the bag. To do this, sandwich the 22 X 24 inch piece of IN-R-Form/Soft n Stable/batting between the fat quarter of inner and outer bag fabric. The fat quarters will be slightly smaller than the Soft N Stable/ In_R-Form/batting. Use either the topstitch thread or embroidery thread on the top and regular sewing thread in the bobbin. Quilt using a straight line gird pattern – either squares or diamonds or just horizontal or vertical lines.
